Miss Pfahlert and the K-2 students enjoyed their time at Mulwala Public School.

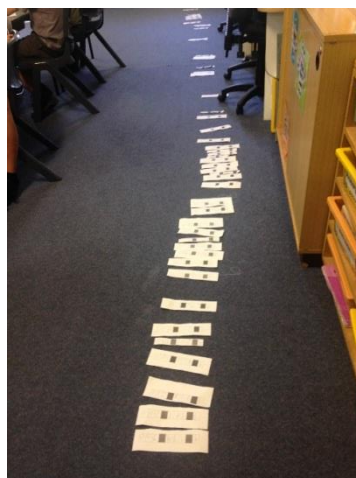


Adelaide was awarded the Small Schools Girls 11 years swimming age champion.
