Basketball Lessons

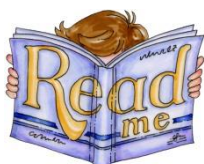
The students will be having basketball lessons this Thursday morning.

The mower is 10 years old and has 570 hours on it. Looks good but parts worn and uses oil. Call into the school during school hours to view if you are interested.

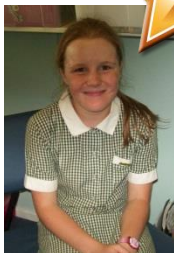
Tendering will be by private bid in sealed envelope and sale will be to the highest bidder.
