experience this term.

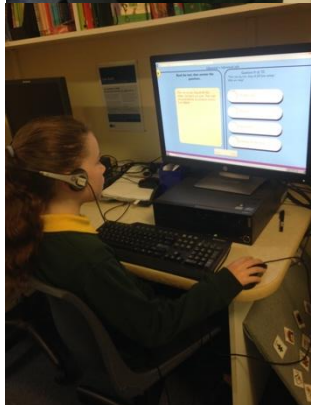
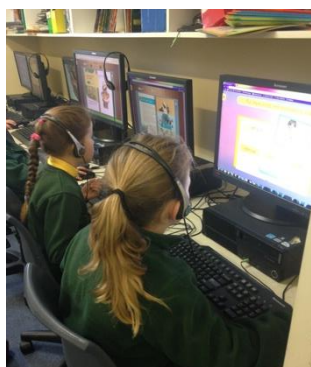
We have received the information about the

They also asked to have a Book Week Parade, Bike Week and a mufti day.

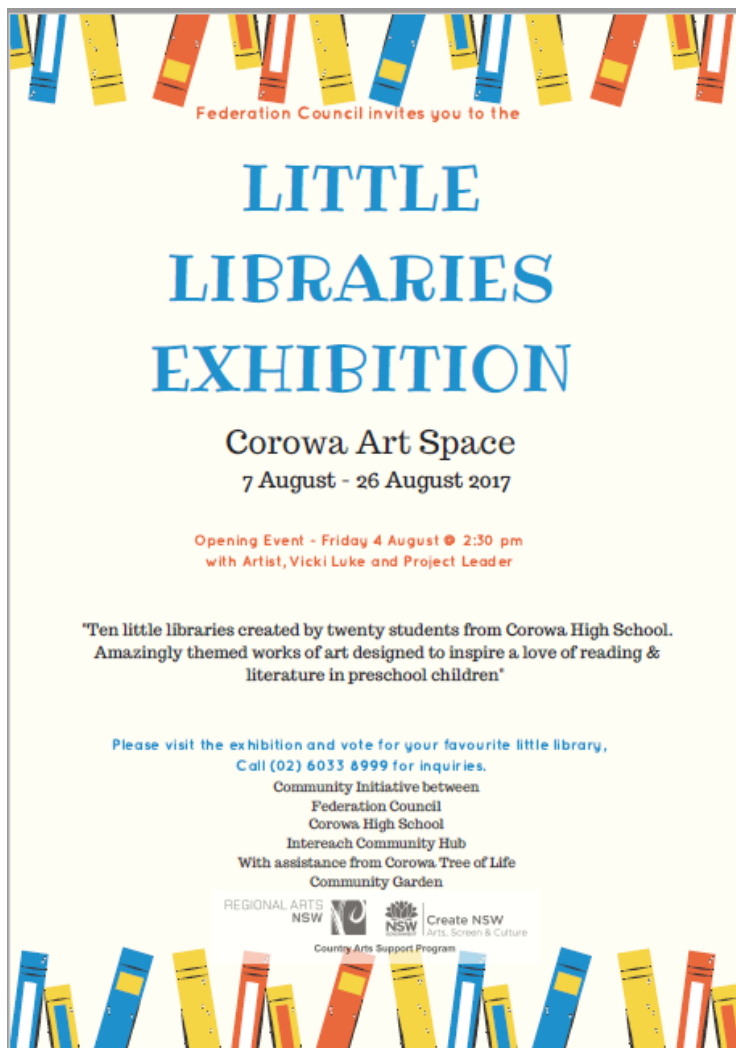
Book Week Parade
