The students learnt all about Ta Moko Tattoos and why they are important to the Maori people. The students experimented with and used different patterns from Maori art.

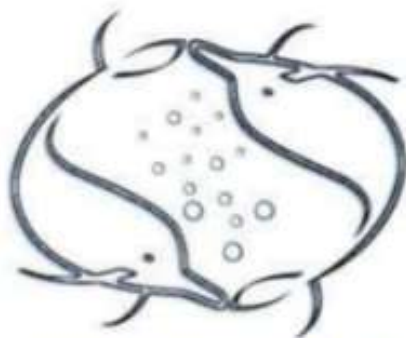


Presentation Books
