Lunchbox scrolls are always popular, but these homemade ones are delicious and can be tailored to your families' favourite flavours (or what is leftover in the fridge!)

Ingredients

- 1 cup self-raising flour (plus a little for rolling)
- 1/2 cup of natural or Greek yoghurt
- 1/3 cup pasta sauce or tomato paste (or pesto)
- 3/4 cup grated cheese
- 2 cups of your favourite pizza toppings

Method

- Preheat oven to 180 degrees and line a baking tray
- Mix flour and yoghurt in a large bowl and knead until it forms a dough like consistency
- Roll into a large rectangle, using additional flour to ensure it does not stick
- Spread pasta sauce, toppings and cheese evenly across the dough
- Roll the dough into a log shape and cut 6 even slices

Place slices on tray and bake for 20-25 minutes (or until golden)



Grated vegetables can be added to the dough without ruining the fluffy texture
