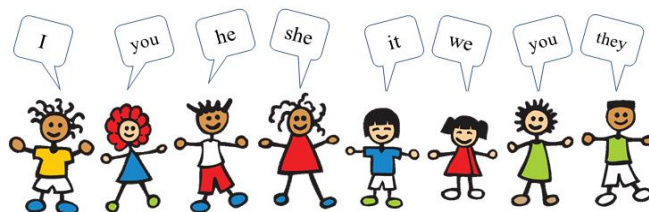
### *An Interview with Oliver*
