St John Eist Aiders

As part of learning to care for their bodies, students have been discussing different first aid scenarios. They have discussed the use & safe storage of medicines. Last week the students practised bandaging a patient who had been bitten by a snake.

Today they looked at some of the resources from the 'Little First Aiders' website, including videos. They practised checking for danger, looking for a response and rolling into a recovery position.

Does your child know their address at home? Can they identify the closest crossroad to tell an emergency operator? Do they remember your phone number?
