Anzac Day

ANZAC stands for Australian and New Zealand Army Corps. The soldiers in those forces became known as ANZACS. Anzac Day is a commemoration of the anniversary of the landing of Australian and New Zealand troops at Gallipoli, Turkey on 25th April in 1915.

As part of the Anzac Day commemorations our students have learnt about Simpson and his donkey and how he used to transport wounded men from the fighting in Monash Valley down to the dressing (first aid) station at Anzac Cove. He was probably the first stretcher-bearer on Gallipoli to use a donkey to transport wounded men. Simpson has become an iconic figure of the Gallipoli campaign and is perhaps the best-known Anzac. He came ashore during the Anzac landing of 25 April 1915 and was killed less than 3 weeks later.

We honour his memory.











The students also got to make Anzac biscuits.




