## Swim School - Corowa Aquatic Centre

Over the last three Mondays our students have been participating in the NSW Department of Education School Swimming Scheme with the students from Rand Public School. This will continue for 2 more weeks.

The focus of this program is on progressive benchmarks, developing water confidence, improving stroke efficiency and providing students with basic skills in water safety and survival.

On the first day of the program, students were grouped based on the distance that they could swim some form of freestyle stroke.

Students are assessed in swimming skills and water safety.

On the final day of the swim program, students are assessed on their freestyle distance and other skills achieved. These results are then transferred to the Certificate of achievement. All school statistics are collated and recorded for the school and the NSW School Sport Unit.

A big thank you to all our parents who have provided our students with delicious platters of fruit, sandwiches and cakes during the program.
