### Welcome Nevaeh

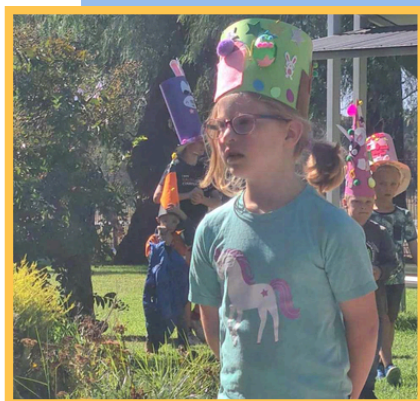
A warm welcome to Nevaeh and her family, who have joined our school community this term! Nevaeh has quickly adapted to our routines and has made many new friends.
